**Order No : A1-7800/2009/KoR Dated. 26-05-2018**

The Seniority List of Reserve Sub Inspectors of Police in respect of Kochi Range for the period from 01.01.2011 to 01.01.2016 was published vide this office order referred 1st above and on the basis of this, a provisional combined State wide Seniority List of Reserve Sub Inspectors of Police has been published vide PHQ letter referred as 2nd above. But the same was not finalised since as per the Govt. order referred 3rd above, the promotions to the Cadre of Closed AR has to be ordered as per the EDP (Expected Date of Promotion) prepared for the respective posts with effect from 01.04.2010.

As per the Govt. order G.O. (P) No.268/2010/Home dtd: 10.12.2010, the District AR and the District Local Police has been integrated to form a common cadre known as Kerala Civil Police as on 01.04.2010. Thereafter the promotions of the persons who opted to remain in AR, has been directed to be done according to the Expected Date of Promotion (EDP) prepared for the base cadre from which the promotion is to be granted. The EDP will be calculated on the basis of existing vacancies and further vacancies arising subsequently on account of retirements, but vacancies arising from deputation posts or any posts in the same or higher rank vacated by those of the AR cadre who opt for serving in the KCP shall not be reckoned as vacancies for promotion. Hence by remaining within the AR cadre, without joining KCP cadre, no person shall lose opportunity for promotion which he could rightfully expect in the situation which existed prior to the creation of KCP, had everyone of his seniors continued in posts in the AR cadre in the same or higher rank, till the retirement of each senior. At the same time, he will also not have any additional benefits by virtue of any of his seniors leaving the AR cadre and joining the KCP cadre.

In the above circumstances as per the PHQ directions contained in the letter read 4th above, a provisional Seniority List of Reserve Sub Inspectors of Police in respect of Kochi Range for the period from 01.01.2011 to 01.01.2018 as per EDP (Expected Date of Promotion) is published herewith. The Seniority Lists. of Reserve Sub Inspectors of Police ordered vide this office letter read 1st above will be cancelled on finalization of this EDP list.

The Unit Heads are requested to circulate the provisional EDP lists among all the concerned without fail under proper acknowledgement. Objections if any received may be forwarded to this office within 10 days with specific remarks without fail. If no objections are received within the time limit specified, it will be presumed that there are no objections against the provisional lists and the same will be finalized. Unit Heads are also requested to verify the date of birth of the persons in this provisional list, in respect of those who are working in their unit and to report to this office, if any discrepancy is noticed.
