

SPECIFICATION

1. It should have a barrel and barrel clamp.
2. It should have a tripod adjustable stand for positioning. The mounting should be stable and should permit movement of the disruptor in all angles.
3. It should have electric firing cartridge and LASER aiming facility.
4. At least 100 numbers of cartridges should be provided at the time of supply. Also the company should assure the uninterrupted supply of the firing cartridges.
5. Remote operation (with cable) from safe distance (Minimum 100 Mtrs)
6. Water bottle, water seals, cleaning brush, blasting machine, firing cable etc should be provided.
7. Body of metallic rust proof material – Certificate should be provided
8. Should be light weight not more than 15 Kgs.
9. Miscellaneous – The firm should provide the following documents/literature (in English language along with the equipment's)
 - a. Strong sturdy and portable Carrying case
 - b. Technical manual with full description of the item
 - c. Users handbook
 - d. Literature on care and preservation technique/methods
 - e. Specifications for packing, handling/transportation/storage
 - f. Details regarding periodical checks to be carried out by the user for serviceability of the equipment.
10. The vendor should impart detailed training free of cost to sufficient personnel at the place(s) specified by the Department.
11. The supplier should have well-equipped office / workshop for maintenance with qualified engineers in repairs/ service. If the equipment needs repairs it should be carried out within 10 days from the date of receipt of intimation.
12. Supplier should have direct authorization from the OEM to participate in the tender. Necessary authorization documents should be made

available in this regard. The name of the OEM along with the contact telephone numbers, addresses, fax numbers & E-mail address may be available for confirmations with the OEM about the status of the supplier.

13. Periodical service minimum once in three months during warranty period.
14. Minimum 3 years warranty for the equipment, battery and for other all accessories.
15. The Firm should provide AMC for a period of 5 years after the warranty period should be enclosed with the tender proposal.
16. AMC should be express as percentage of total product value (TPV) separately for each year of AMC.
17. Tenders will be evaluated based on the net liability to the department which includes Product cost and AMC cost.
