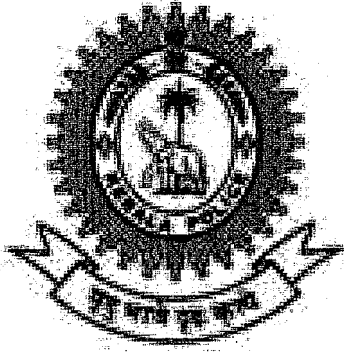

01.Chief Minister's Police Medals for excellence in service are being awarded to Police officers/personnel up to the rank of DySP/ACP in recognition of excellent work and devotion to duty in accordance with the rules and procedures prescribed in the references cited 1 to 3.

02.Government revised the guidelines by amending the existing rules and procedures relating to the award of the Chief Minister's Police Medal and revised orders were issued vide reference cited 4th and 5th.

03.Henceforth, the Chief Minister's Police Medals will be awarded to 285 personnel of and below the officers in the rank of SP (non IPS)/Commandant. The medal recipient shall be rewarded with of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) as Cash award irrespective of their ranks.

04.The calendar for inviting application and awarding Chief Minister's Police Medals is as follows:

Date of Notification	1 st of June
Last Date of submission of applications by unit heads to HoDs	15 th of July
Recommendations to be forwarded to Government from the HoD	15 th of August
Announcement of Medals	2 nd of October
Investiture Ceremony	1 st of November - "Kerala Piravi Day"


05. The Police Officers / Personnel who are not awarded with any major penalty during the last 10 years of service and not with any minor penalties during the last 3 years of service are eligible to apply for the award. Over all service performance of the Police Officer / Personnel shall be considered while making recommendations.

06. The eligibility criteria and quota of medals to each unit is attached as Annexure I and II respectively.

07. The Circular & ED read above is modified to this extent.

ANNEXURE I

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CHIEF MINISTER'S POLICE MEDAL

- ❖ To be eligible for the award, a member of the service should have completed 10 years of service in the Police force on the 1st March of every year.
- ❖ The officer/personnel applied for the medal has not been punished with major penalty during the last 10 years of service and not with any minor penalties within the last 3 years. Overall service records may also be considered while making recommendations.
- ❖ The award should not be recommended to those police personnel who had been presented with the Medal in earlier years.
- ❖ It should also be ensured that Departmental or Vigilance Enquiries/Crime cases/Vigilance Cases/Private Complaints etc. are not pending against them/Contemplated against them. If any enquiry/case has subsequently been taken against the persons already recommended, that details may also be reported to PHQ quoting the earlier reference without fail.
- ❖ The overall reputations of the officer should be good and they should not be adverse information on record about his conduct in private life also which has been verified and found prima-fascia. The APAR/CR/Grading (which ever is applicable) for last ten years should have at least seven or more in the Good, Very Good or Outstanding category.
