Sub: Forensic Science Laboratory - Guidelines for Investigating Officers -
Standing Instructions- Reg.

The progress of Science & Technology has immensely contributed to the development of Forensic Science. The Forensic Science Laboratory in Kerala has acquired several new capabilities in the recent past. We have set up several modern equipments for the examination of materials obtained during the process of investigation.

The Director, Forensic Science Laboratory has prepared detailed notes on the facilities available in State Forensic Science Laboratory for examination of materials, the nature of examinations which can be undertaken in the laboratory, the queries which can be answered by the scientists and the precautions to be taken during the process of collection of physical evidence and of dispatch of materials to the laboratory.

These guidelines formulated by the Director, Forensic Science Laboratory are to be complied with by all officers in the department while handling, collecting and forwarding materials to the laboratory for examination and while posing questions to be answered by the Scientists.

These will be deemed to be the instructions issued as standing orders by the Director General of Police. The booklet containing the guidelines will be read as annexure to this Circular.
