Detailed instructions have been issued as per PHQ Circular No.17/2014 regarding action to be taken in the investigation of cases of missing persons/children on the basis of the instructions issued by the National Human Rights Commissions. The following instructions are being issued for strict compliance of all the units:-


All incidents of missing children in the state should mandatorily be reported to the newly constituted National Commission for Protection of Child Rights(NCPCR) in the address given below, within 24 hours of such occurrence. Failure to report promptly would give rise to the presumption that there was an attempt to suppress the incident. The reporting should be done promptly and the procedure could be the same as is being followed by the concerned authorities for reporting custodial death cases to the NHRC.
