Sub: Maintaining of Process Register (KPF 149) in a new format - Orders issued

Ref: Judgment dtd:9/9/11 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Crl. Appeal No.1758/11 arising out of SLP (Crl).No.5412/08.

Based on the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the above judgment, all SHOs of Police Stations are directed to maintain process register (KPF 149) in a new format as given below.

The SHO of the concerned Police Station shall ensure that each warrant of arrest issued by the Court when received is duly entered in the said register and is formally entrusted to a responsible officer for execution. On the date fixed for the return of the warrant, when the Court called for a compliance report on the action taken, a clear, cogent and legible report may be furnished by a Superior Police Officer, so as to facilitate fixing of responsibility in case of misuse.

The new format of Process Register (KPF 149) will come into force with immediate effect.
