DPCs to convene monthly meets of SHOs

The State Police Chief Loknath Behera has directed the District Police Chiefs to convene monthly conference of the SHOs in addition to the crime conferences organized every month.

It has also been directed to send the action taken reports of the meeting to the State Police Chief and other senior police officers. The State Police Chief has stated that the SHO conference and crime conference should not be conducted simultaneously. The move comes in the wake of a decision taken after the SHO conference chaired by the Chief Minister held on 4th January at Kerala Police Academy.

The DPCs have been tasked with the responsibility of reviewing activities relating to Janamaithri, in-house training, technology utilization, compliance with green protocol, cleanliness, operations of crime and criminal tracking networking systems etc. It aims at bringing more responsibility to the Police Stations and making the stations public friendly. The DPCs are also directed to give more preference to things relating to human resource development.

The State Police Chief will interact with all SHOs through video conference on the last Fridays or Saturdays of every month. All District Police Chiefs and Sub divisional officers will participate in the meeting. The

State Police Chief has also added that all these modifications were done to increase the efficiency of Police Stations thereby providing professional service without bias to the public.
