The facilities are set up according to the need of police in the modern world. Adequate rooms for police personnel, Rooms for keeping mainour and weapons, conference hall, CD File Stock Room, Interrogation Room are some of them. Computer, Wi-Fi, Camera Monitoring Systems etc have been set up with the help of modern technology. Habitat has finished construction of the building at a cost of Rupees 2.2 Crores. The building has been constructed in an eco friendly way by minimizing the cost of construction.
