Special Police System for providing Medicines to the critical patients

The State Police Chief Loknath Behera has stated that Police have come up with an ample system for transporting life saving medicines to the critical patients across the State.

Special vehicles have been arranged in Kochi and Thiruvananthapuram for the system. District Police Chief, Thiruvananthapuram Rural and Deputy Police Commissioner, Kochi will be in charge of this initative. Harshitha Attalluri, South Zone IGP, has been nominated as the State Nodal Officer for the successful execution of the system.

People may contact the number 112 for availing this service of Police. The police collect the packet including the details of the patient such as Name, Address, Phone Number and Police Station and inform the Nodal Officer. The Nodal Officer will give necessary instructions to provide medicines at the particular place by special vehicles or Highway Patrol Vehicles.

Medical College Police Station in Thiruvananthapuram and Central Police Station in Kochi will act as the collection centre for medicines. Doctors, Hospital Authorities and Relatives can bring medicines to these centers. If the medicines are to be sent within the district, the concerned District Police Chiefs will collect the medicines and distribute with the help of the Janamaithri Police.
