Sub: SCRB Estt: - Appointment of Finger Print Searchers by transfer from among the Ministerial Subordinate Service of Police Dept. and Vigilance Dept. – Application called for - Reg:-

Ref : 1. GO(MS) No.102/73/Home dated 11/06/1973 and subsequent amendments.

Approximately 9 (Nine) vacancies of Finger Print Searchers in the scale of pay Rs.30,700 – 65,400 in the State Finger Print Bureau are to be filled up by transfer from among the willing and qualified hands of the Ministerial Subordinate Service of the Police Department and Vigilance Department.

The following qualifications are prescribed for appointment on the post of Finger Print Searcher:

- 1. A degree in Chemistry or Physics from a recognized University.
- 2. a) Must be certified to posess the visual standards specified below without glasses

Right EyeLeft EyeDistant Vision6/6 (Snellen)6/6 (Snellen)Near vision0.5 (Snellen)0.5 (Snellen)

- b) Colour blindness squint or any morbid condition of the eyes or lids of either eye shall be deemed to be disqualification.
- 3. Must not have completed or will not complete 36 years of age as on first day of January 2020.

Probation: Every person appointed to this category shall be on probation from the date on which she/ he join duty for a period of 2 (Two) years on duty within a

continuous period of 3 (three) years.

Bond : Every person appointed shall execute a Bond undertaking to service the





State Government for a period not less than three years after training and to pay the State Government a sum of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) in case to fail to serve the State Government

**Training** 

: Those who are appointed to the post of Finger Print Searcher undergo training for a period of 6 (six) months in the Finger Print Bureau, Thiruvananthapuram and shall pass the examination prescribed for such training within the period of probation.

The application; along with the bio-data and the prescribed medical certificate, may be obtained from the willing employees and forwarded to this office on or before 15.02.2020. The delayed applications will not be entertained.
