Aluva Police Saved the Life of a Youth who fainted in his Car

Always keep an eye on your way. There may be someone waiting for your help. Recently the act of a traveler and the vigil of police brought back a youth to his normal life after he was found unconscious in his vehicle near the Companyy Metro Station in Aluva in Ernakulam Rural Police limits.

Muhammed Shiyas, a traveler, on his journey from Ernakulam to Aluva, at around 7:00 PM found a car stopped in the middle of the National Highway without parking lights. Other vehicles passing by may hit that car. While overtaking from left Muhammed Shiyas noticed that the driver in that car seen fell on the steering and hence he thought that the driver was drunk. Later he felt suspicious regarding the position of the car. So he came back and knocked the window but the driver did not respond as he just tried to move his head. Music system was playing in high volume inside the car.

While he tried to signal other drivers he saw Ernakulam Rural Additional SP's Vehicle. E N Suresh, Ernakulam Rural Additional SP, rushed out from his vehicle and enquired the matter to Muhammed Shiyas. On hearing, he tried to wake up the driver and to open the car. But he could not make it. Suddenly he contacted the Aluva Police Station and summoned more police personnel. He also managed to stop people from crowding in an effort to maintain Covid Protocol. Within seconds N Suresh Kumar, Inspector, Aluva and his team rushed to the spot. As there was no other way to open the door, the Inspector broke the rear glass and

opened the door. The Inspector got injured while breaking the glass. But he didn't spare time and been in the front- line to give first aid to the driver and to send him to the hospital in the same vehicle. The driver, a native of Alappuzha, went unconscious due to low blood pressure.

The Inspector was very happy and proud to save the life of a youth after giving first-aid at the right moment though he got injured and had four stitches in his hand while rescuing the person from the car. Due to the drastic spread of COVID 19, he has been brought to hospital in the same car after taking all COVID 19 precautionary measures. Muhammed Shiyas thus showcased himself as a role model for others for his good act.
